

Facilities

Cabins:

During summer camp, most campers stay in one of our 8 camp cabins. Each cabin has 5 bunkbeds, desk area for the counselors, wall heater, and electricity. The four upper cabins were hand built in the late 60's by Otto Laggervall whose small company Yakima Mechanics went on to become the giant Yakima Car Rack Systems. The four lower cabins were also built around the same time. One year boys are on the hill and girls get the lower cabins, then we swap the next year.

Showerhouse:

The centrally located shower house serves the camper cabins with restroom and shower facilities. Each shower has a curtain and toilet stall has a door to ensure the privacy and modesty of our campers.

Shinn Lodge:

Shinn is our two story lodge, and generally houses backpackers and CIT's. Occasionally we'll have an interesting age mix that will require becoming a "super cabin" and they will stay in Shinn. This one is popular with campers since it has indoor plumbing and showers.

Harvey Hunt Hall:

Our dining hall, named after long time Assistant Camp Director Harvey Hunt, is a beautiful building in the center of camp. The dining hall houses the main dining room and kitchen from where all of our meals are served. The staff have a camper-free lounge at one end of the building where they can take breaks, and the other end is home to our Outdoor Environmental Education program as well as our Backpacking classroom.

Swimming Pool:

The Clive Green Pool is right on Clear Lake, and a great attraction on hot days!

Low and High Ropes Challenge Course:

Completely rebuilt in 2005, our Challenge Course is used extensively during the summer months. The low course consists of group challenges designed to build trust and teamwork among the cabin groups. Campers ages 10 and up are eligible to get onto the high course, which is more of a personal challenge. We are excited about the addition of a 36' climbing tower which will provide us the ability to get even our youngest campers off the ground!
